Yarn Acrylic DK, 100g x3

Equipment 4.5 mm Crochet Hook
Stitch markers
Large eye needle

1m + shoe lace

One size pattern, but size changes can be made by using a bigger or smaller hook.

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Sleeves

Pattern = (dc 2 in 2 ch space, ch2)

Ch 51

R 1: sc in second ch from hook, sc 49, turn [50 sc total]

R 2: ch 3, dc 49, turn

R 3: ch 3, dc, ch 2, sk 2 st, * dc 2, ch 2, sk 2 st , rpt * to * 10 more times, dc 2, turn

R 4: ch 4, pattern x 11, dc 2, ch 1, sk 1 st, dc, turn

R 5: ch 3, dc, ch 2, sk 2 st, pattern x 11, dc 2, turn

R 6: ch 3, dc in same st as turning ch, ch 1, sk 1 st, pattern x 11, ch 1, sk 1 st, two dc in last st, turn

R 7: ch 3, dc 2 [second dc goes in 1 ch space], ch 2, sk 2 st, pattern x 11, dc in 1 ch space, dc 2, turn

R 8: ch 5 [turning dc and 2 ch], sk 2 st, pattern x 12, dc, turn

R 9: ch 3, dc in same st as turning ch, pattern x 12, dc 2 in 2 ch space, dc 2 in last st, turn

R 19: ch 3, dc 2 [second dc goes in 1 ch space], ch 2, sk 2 st, pattern x 13, dc in 1 ch space, dc 2, turn

R 20: ch 5, [turning dc and 2 ch], sk 2 st, pattern x 14, dc, turn

R 21: ch 3, dc in same st as turning ch, pattern x 14, dc 2 in 2 ch space, dc 2 in last st, turn

R 22: ch 3, dc, ch 2, sk 2 st, pattern x 14, dc 2, turn

 R 52: ch 5, [turning dc and 2 ch], sk 2 st, pattern x 20, dc, turn
 R 53: ch 3, dc in same st as turning ch, pattern x 20, dc 2 in 2 ch space, dc 2 in last st, turn
 R 54: ch 3, dc 85, turn
 R 55: ch 1, sl st 6, begdc3tog, dc 70, dc3tog, turn
 R 56 – R 65: begdc3tog, dc across, dc3tog, turn [dc count reduces by 4 stitches each row]
 R 66, begdc3tog, dc 26, dc3tog, turn
 Do not tie off yarn, continue directly with tab loops

Tabs

R 1: begdc2tog, dc 2, dc2tog, turn

R 2: ch 3, dc 3, turn

R 3: ch 3, dc 3, turn

R 4: ch 3, dc in same st as turning chain, dc 2, 2 dc in last st, ch 1, turn

Fold tab so R 4 overlays R 1

Place hook around post of first stitch of R 1 ...



... and through first st of R 4, and then sc 1 the two together

Repeat this across the remaining 5 stitches of the tab

sc 5 across top of sleeve,

Repeat R 1 – R 4 for second tab, folding over and securing in the same way

sc 5 across top of sleeve

Repeat R 1 – R 4 for third tab, folding over and securing in the same way.

Tie off and cut yarn.

Sewing together

Fold the sleeve so wrong side is outside. The wrong side is determined by the tabs, as there is a ridge of stitches that should be against the body rather than visible. Line up holes along seam, from cuff to armpit. Use a flexible stitch, such as mattress stitch to sew the sleeve together.

Sew in all ends



Thread shoe lace through the tabs and use them to adjust fit.
